Dear Ms. Davis:

Congratulations! We are thrilled to share the news that the benefactors of the scholarship named above, Messrs Karl Thompson, '80, and Maurice Thompson, '82, have chosen to extend their support to your son, Justin Francis, for an unprecedented additional year for this school year 2024/2025. After meeting Justin during a visit to the school and reviewing his impressive academic achievements last year in Grade 9, the Thompson brothers are excited to offer this unique opportunity to assist with Justin's school expenses.

The requirements to remain on the scholarship will still apply, and last year's signed application, signed by you and Justin, will continue to acknowledge your understanding of the [strict requirements](#) that Justin **shall follow** to remain eligible to receive the scholarship benefits **after** this initial term. Those are:

1. Failure to maintain solid academic standing or progress may result in the suspension or termination of the scholarship. Maintain academic solid standing or progress.
2. Maintain a 95% attendance record.
3. Be free of any disciplinary issues.

4. Participate in school co-curricular life by being in a school-sanctioned club or being a member of a school sports team; and

At the end of every school term, Justin must email the scholarship committee (s [REDACTED]) to update them on his grades, school activities, and general school life. This should be done within [number] days of the term's end.

The scholarship provides funding of approximately JM\$150,000, **until depleted**, for the following and shall be disbursed through the school's Bursar:

1. \$750 per day for bus fare to and from school for five days per week and
2. \$600 for school lunch five days per week,

Since Justin has already earned the bonus by receiving a laptop last year, this part of the expected benefits does not apply.

We trust Justin will continue to thrive at Calabar and maximize every opportunity to excel in his studies and school activities. We believe in him and are committed to supporting Calabar in shaping young boys into the responsible men of tomorrow.

We are deeply grateful to Calabar Florida Alumni members Karl Thompson, '80, and Maurice Thompson, '82, (as well as the co-contributors mentioned above) for their unwavering commitment to funding this scholarship in memory of Vincent and Sylvia Thompson. Their support is a testament to the strong community that surrounds Justin and all the scholarship recipients.
