

The scholarship provides funding of approximately US\$1,000, effective November 1, 2022 for the following and shall be disbursed by the school's Bursar until the scholarship amount is exhausted':

- a. JM\$600 for bus fare to and from school (from outside Corporate Area- Old Harbour) for five days per week, and
- b. JM\$600 for school lunch five days per week.
