Thomp	ar Alumni Florida has been able to establish funding for the second annual Vincent and Sylvia oson Scholarship for the 2022-2023 school year. The scholarship committee selected Matthew e, Grade 12 (), as this year's awardee.
The so	holarship provides US\$1,000. First, this shall provide for IM\$200/day bus fare for five days per y

The scholarship provides US\$1,000. First, this shall provide for JM\$200/day bus fare for five days per week and \$600 for school lunch for five days per week. Second, for JM\$7,500 towards school uniform. Then, finally, the remaining balance will be applied toward school or examination fees. Since some thirty-five days of school have already passed, the lunch and bus fare amounts for these days are applied to the school/exam fee category. Therefore, estimating 196 school days and less 35 days, the calculations below are based on 161 school days remaining starting November 1, 2022.
