As a result of additional benefactors coming on board, Calabar Alumni Florida is pleased to announce that funding for a second Thompson scholarship is secured. The scholarship is awarded to Justin Francis, the next eligible applicant.

The scholarship provides US\$1,000 in funds for transportation and lunch. Until the funding of JM\$150,000 is exhausted, Justin will receive JM\$750/day for bus fare five days per week and \$600 for school lunch. Unfortunately, due to the higher cost of his transportation fees, no funds remain for uniforms or fees.

Using October 30, 2023, as the effective date of the scholarship, the following have been estimated.
