4. Participate in school co-curricular life by being in a school-sanctioned club or being a member of a school sports team; and
5. At the end of every school term, email the scholarship committee (scholarship@scbarfla.org) to update them on his grades, school activities and general school life.

The scholarship provides approximately US\$1,000 for the school year, provided the above requirements are maintained each term. The school's Bursar will make disbursements in installments, usually at the beginning of each term, until the scholarship amount is exhausted.

- A one-time \$7,500 contribution for purchasing two sets of school uniforms;
- \$200 for bus fare to and from school for five days per week;
- \$600 for school lunch five days per week, and
- \$7,200 towards school or exam fees.

We have full confidence in Denzel's abilities and potential. We believe that with your continued support and his dedication, he will excel in his studies and school activities at Calabar. We hope that he will make the most of this opportunity to grow and succeed.
