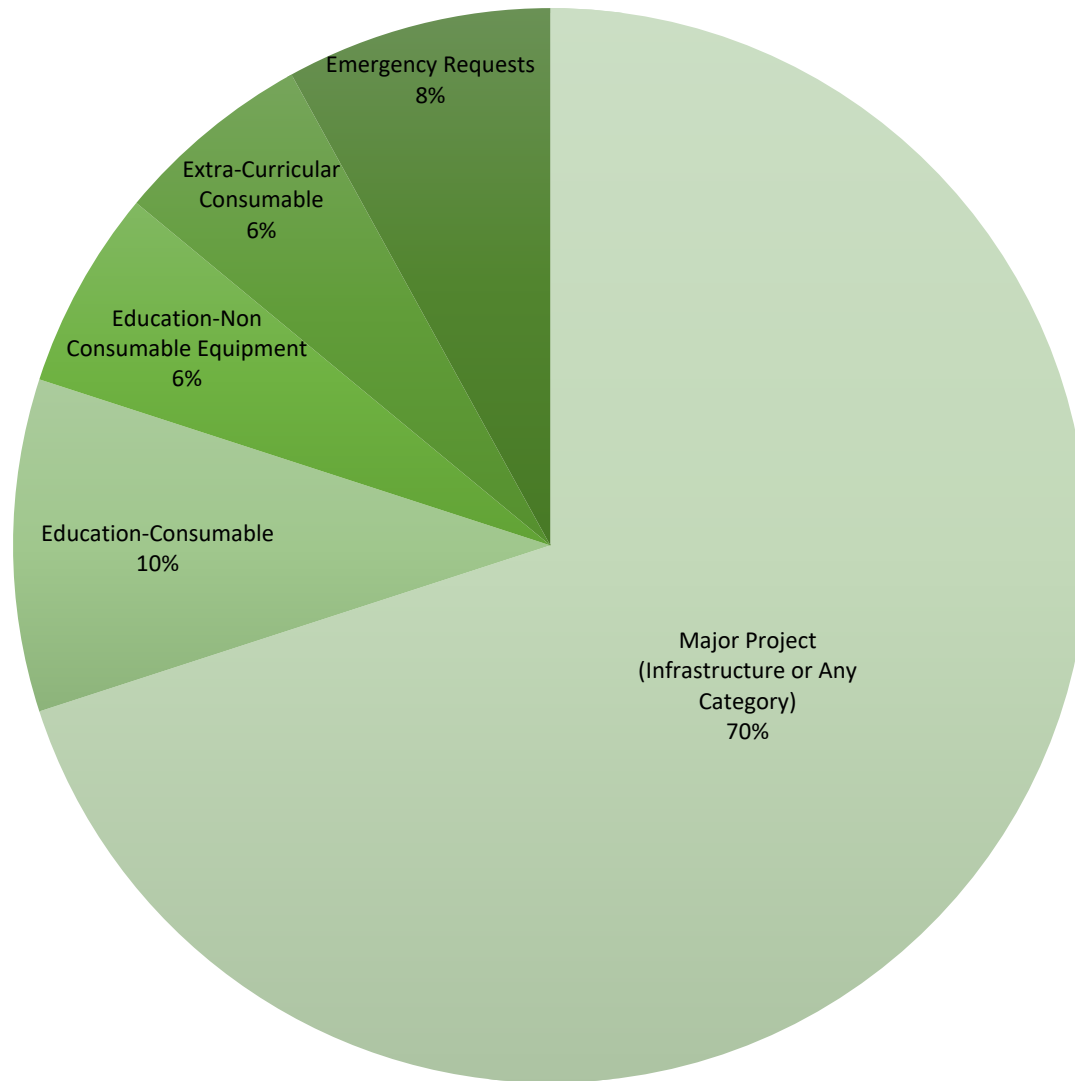
Name of Category	Definition of Category
Education Consumable	Goods or money given for single-use educational items that are consumed once. E.g., scholarships, USB drives, teacher appreciation cash gift,
Education Non-Consumable Equipment	Goods or money given for educational-related items that multiple people can utilize over multiple years with a life expectancy of 3 to 5 years . E.g., library books, classroom projectors, lab Equipment.
Extra-Curricular Consumable (sports, clubs, SCQ)	Goods or money given for extra-curricular programs that are single use or consumed once . E.g., the track team food, school challenge team food, athletic shoes, etc.
Emergency Requests	Requests made on an emergency or urgent basis for goods or money that benefit the Florida Chapter, school, a student or teacher. An emergency request requires unanimous vote of the Board of Directors.
Infrastructure	Goods or money given for the improvement of the physical plant or grounds of the school with a general life span of 7 to 10 years.

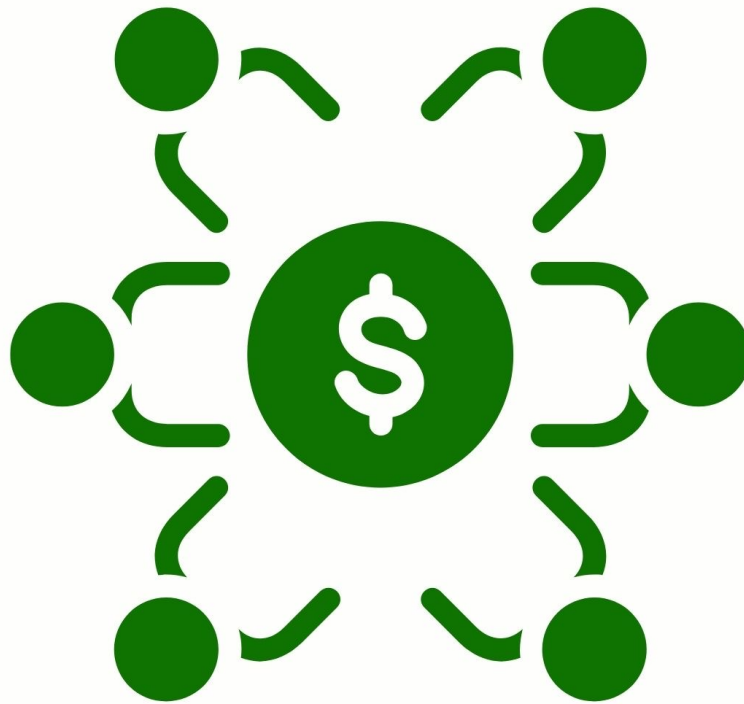




